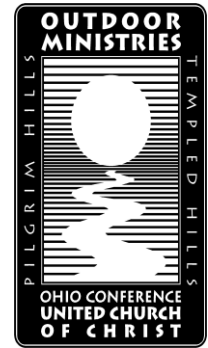


Hello, Summer Guest!

ITEMS TO BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO CAMP:

1. Please fill out the buff colored **health form**.
A parent or legal guardian needs to sign in the box highlighted "Important" at the bottom of page 1. We **encourage** you to have your doctor complete the "Health Care Recommendations" on the last page.
2. Please fill out the **Transportation Release Form** so we know exactly who to release your child to at the end of camp.
3. Please read and sign the "**Agreement to Participate.**"

Please mark all of your belongings with your name, and REMEMBER TO BRING ALL OF YOUR COMPLETED FORMS WITH YOU TO CAMP. **DO NOT MAIL THEM TO THE CONFERENCE OFFICE.**

Who doesn't love to get mail from home? Be sure to mark your cards/postcards with camp name/number (choir camp/1105) on the lower left hand side of the envelope/postcard.

Please do not bring snacks, electrical appliances (such as radios, TV's, hair dryers, or curling irons, power tools), pets, firearms or weapons of any kind, firecrackers, explosives or igniters, non-prescribed drugs, alcohol, pagers, cell phones (Camp is a time to turn off/leave behind cells. Both camps have phones in an emergency).

No Nit Policy: Because of the highly contagious nature of head lice, Outdoor Ministries Summer Program has a "no nit policy." If nits are discerned at camper registration, the camper will not be allowed to stay at camp. We are sorry for any inconvenience this might cause.

Refund Policy: Cancellations must be received at least 10 days before the start of the event, unless there is a medical or family emergency. The \$75 deposit is non-refundable. Once the camper is on site, no refund is available if the camper leaves early.

Insurance: The Outdoor Ministries' insurance covers treatment costs in excess of the camper's insurance up to \$15,000 per claim. The providing of primary health insurance and related insured or uninsured costs is the responsibility of the participant/ parent or legal guardian.
